Development Approval for the Dulacca Wind Farm

RES has today been granted Development Approval for its Dulacca Wind Farm located in the Western Downs region of Queensland. The project will comprise of up to 56 wind turbines, battery storage and ancillary infrastructure. The project will connect into the existing transmission network located adjacent to the project.

Llion Parry, Development Project Manager at RES, commented “The wind farm development approval is a significant milestone for the project and we are excited to bring a clean energy project of this scale to the Western Downs region. The project will make a significant contribution to the Queensland Government’s target of reaching 50% of electricity generated from renewable energy by 2030.”

When constructed, the project is expected generate enough clean energy to power the equivalent of 150,000 homes. It will create around 400 jobs during its construction, and a further 35 during the 30 year operation of the wind farm, alongside other associated economic benefits for the region. The project will also offer a community fund for local good causes, with a value of \$1.25m over the lifetime of the project.

RES’s Chief Executive Officer, Matt Rebbeck, noted “We look forward to working further with the State Government, local council, local community and other key stakeholders to deliver the Dulacca Wind Farm for the region. The project is a significant step in supporting Queensland’s energy transition, and reducing bills for consumers”.
